Multiple dogs will be allowed to compete, titling dogs <u>must</u> be run before non-titling dogs if they are running at the same level.

For Exhibition Only entries permitted | Day of Show entries will NOT be permitted

All High in Trial awards will not be awarded if there are fewer than 25 entries per day.

Registration Entry and Closing:

• Pre-entries close on March 31, 2019 or when the trial fills.





- Please check your entry before you submit it for level & Novice A & B classes
- Entries will be awarded in order of receipt.
- When payment is received by the host, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from Living with Dogs with information about volunteering and lunch.
- All dogs must have valid USCSS registration numbers to compete in this trial. All handlers must be members of USCSS to compete in this trial.
- Vehicle, Interior, Container & Exterior classes will NOT be nested searches. You will be able to run two dogs for titles if the dogs are at different levels.
- If you are running dogs in the same level, titling dogs must be run first, FEO dogs can be run after titling dogs.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawal after March 30; a \$35 processing fee will be withheld for all cancellations.
- No refund will be made if the team is absent, disqualified or excused by a judge for any reason.
